
Part 2: Family Tips: Supporting Students with ADHD During Distance Learning

Welcome to part two of "Family Tips"-- a series of strategies and tools to help meet our students' needs while we are apart for distance learning. This week, we look at how to make the most of audio and video features on our learning platforms (Seesaw, Google Suite) and devices.

1. Access directions in multiple formats.

Most assignments are introduced in live Zoom meetings, and they are posted with written instructions on Seesaw (KP-4th) or Google Classroom (5th-8th). If your child is still not sure of what to do, explore additional options with teachers. Teachers may be able to provide recorded verbal instructions on Seesaw or recordings of Zoom classes for playback.





2. Try text-to-speech tools.

While students are on devices for learning, typing will play a role. Providing alternatives by using text-to-speech and other voice tools could help to alleviate any frustration. <u>Utilize the video and voice recorder options on Seesaw. Enable Siri. Adjust "Accessibility" options on Apple devices to turn on "Spoken Content." Voice typing on Google Docs works well too!</u>
