Menlo Park Safe Routes to School

The City of Menlo Park Safe Routes to School program
is collecting data on biking and walking safety near
the schools this spring through a survey and
community meetings in June 2021. The intention is to
obtain more data and observations from parents,
school staff, students and residents on transportation
during school hours and see if improvements can be
made through current and future projects or
maintenance. The survey (including a public input
map) and the community meetings are preliminary
steps to walk audits that would be conducted in Menlo
Park public schools, as proposed (but not yet funded)
by the Master Transportation Plan. The survey is open
until May 10, 2021.
