Summer Structure Reminder

(Repeated from April 16th email)

We will run two full day, four-week summer sessions for students in Kindergarten through third grade. Swimming will be suspended for this summer given the construction that will commence on the community center (May or June start likely).

- **Cohort A:** June 21st - July 16th, 2021
- **Cohort B:** July 19th - August 12th

The school day will be extended to a traditional model:

- School Day 8:30 am - 2:50 pm
- Drop-off 8:15 am - 8:30 am
- Pick-up 2:55 pm - 3:15 pm

This is a required part of our program for KG to incoming 3rd grade.

Next Fall In-Person Planning

We have begun to shift our focus to fall. We are hopeful that the 2021-2022 school year will look more typical, however some changes will still be in place. Assuming we are able to maintain open doors, the following is anticipated.

- In-Person Learning 5 days a week, full day
 - Full enrollment expected
- Start times to allow for staggered entry/exit will continue though the timing may change
- Social distancing
 - Campus visitors will continue to be restricted
- Virus safety protocols will continue including
 - Masks for students and staff
 - Hand sanitization & health screenings
 - Zoned campus use during break times
- Status of field trips/special activities is unsure
- Cross grade level parent meetings will be held virtually
