Project Look provides fun, educational, and memorable art experiences to thousands of students in Palo Alto and the surrounding area every year. Designed for kindergarten through fifth grade classrooms, this fieldtrip consists of a 45-minute inquiry-based tour of the contemporary art gallery followed by a 45-minute hands-on art lesson where students create their own artwork inspired by the work on view. This well-rounded fieldtrip, focused on seeing and making, offers students and teachers a museum experience led by professional artist educators.

This exhibition is a celebration of the diverse, personal, and infinitely varied "disability experience." Every artist featured has one or more disabilities, whether visible or invisible and the exhibition centers upon their creativity, vulnerability, and unique perspectives. The artwork includes traditional portraiture, mixed media pieces, tactile paintings, ceramics, an interactive labyrinth experience, digital portraiture, video, installation art and a large site-specific sculpture. Inspired by the art on view, students will create their own accessible artwork.
