Reading Stamina

Students across many grade levels have been working on continuing to build up their reading stamina. Reading stamina is how long a student or a class can read independently without disruption or interruption.

This week, we celebrated 1st grade with a quick music blast/dance party because they have worked together to get their reading stamina up to 14 minutes. Nice job, 1st grade! Check in with your child. How long can they read uninterrupted for? In middle school, SSR (Sustained Silent Reading) is twice per week. That is a great time for them to build up their stamina, in addition to reading at home.

Hot Tip! Car Books

Keeping a small bin of books in the car is a great way to get kids reading. Consider this:

- Putting easy readers in the car can encourage independent reading. Kids may even read aloud to you!
- Nonfiction picture books can foster interest in a special topic or allow some time for readers to notice the many helpful features of nonfiction books.
- Picture books and graphic novels are great for readers who want to read but want to focus on more than just text.

Our "Free Books" cart will be making an appearance at the gate on some mornings. Tell your child to check it out and pick some books for the car.

CALIFORNIA MANDATORY HELMET LAW
